


How to use Drosoflipper:

Filter



Bypass



Slide the filter into the support.





Slide standard 25 mm vials with rim into support until they click. Vials may contain anaesthetised flies for lifespan or negative geotaxis assays.






You can leave the vials attached to Drosoflipper™ as long as needed. This could be for stock keeping, for lifespan experiments, for climbing/negative geotaxis assays, etc



To transfer flies, slide fresh food or empty vials into the upper slots. Make sure they click.




Tap Drosoflipper™ down, repeat until all flies 5 are at the bottom of the vials.




Flies at the bottom of the vials.


Introduce the bypass into the edge of the support. Tap down again if required.



While the flies remain at the bottom, slide the bypass in, pushing the filter out to the edge without letting it fall.



Flip it over.



Slide the filter back in, pushing the bypass out. Remove the old vials.
